17th Edition Wiring Regulations Update Day Update (C&G 2382-20)

One-day update on wiring regulations for experienced electricians, who already have a 2381 qualification on the regulations but require bringing up to date. Receive a FREE handbook on this course.

Design, Commission & Inspect Fire Alarms Systems (NA-FA2-2)

Two-day advanced course is designed for people for whom installation of fire alarms is an integral part of their business, to enable them to design, install, test and commission multi-zone systems that contain control and indicating equipment designed for commercial or industrial premises in compliance with BS 5839 part 1. An introductory level NA-FA1-2 is available and needs to be completed before booking this advanced course.

Using Test Instruments (NA-UTI-1)

One-day practical course on a range of test instruments from various manufacturers.

Inspection, Testing and Certification (C&G-2391)

Four-day course and assessment covering certification of minor works, electrical installation certificates, periodic inspection and testing certificates followed by a practical assessment day set by City & Guilds on set dates throughout the year. Delegates are advised to bring their own test equipment which must have current verification or calibration documentation.

Electricians' Certificate of Competence (NA-ECC-6)

Six-day advanced refresher course and assessment on the design, installation, inspection, testing, verification and certification of installations. This course is for electricians and electrical inspectors, in preparation for assessment leading to a Certificate of Competence to the NAPIT Standard by a UKAS Accredited Certification Body which includes two-hour written examination followed, after the course, by a one-day practical assessment (for candidates who are successful in the theory examination).

Emergency Lighting (NA-EM-1)

One-day course covering the installation of emergency lighting in domestic and commercial premises.

Completion of Certificates and Reports (NA-CR-1)

One-day course for electricians familiar with technical aspects of inspection and testing on minor works, electrical installation and periodic reports covering NAPIT certification and the notification process.

Allied Trades Part P course (NA-DCC-10)

Ten-day course on basic electrical installation in the domestic sector, including a one-day practical accredited assessment (if successful in the theory) for those carrying out electrical work in allied trades. Successful completion does not prepare the candidate to work as a fully qualified electrician.

Certificate for the Code of Practice for In-service Inspection and Testing of Electrical Equipment (C&G 2377)

Two-day course to cover the implementation of a systematic and regular programme of maintenance, inspection and testing of electrical equipment in use by employees, appliances used by the public and hired, supplied, repaired or serviced equipment by a workplace.

Building Regulations for Electrical Installations in Dwellings (C&G 2393)

One-day course suitable for those working in the building trades in England and Wales and those who require a working knowledge of how electrical installations in dwellings can affect the building construction. Does not cover Scotland and Northern Ireland.
