Main Purpose of the Role

We are looking to recruit a full time regional inspection manager to be part of the Inspection team responsible for the south east and London. North & south of the Thames, reaching out to Kent, Sussex, Hampshire, Northamptonshire, Cambridgeshire and Norfolk/Suffolk. You will report to the head of Inspection and must reside in one of these areas.

Job Description:

Primarily responsible for leading and managing the field officers in this region (up to 16), who carry out inspection and assessment of NAPIT's members across the electrical, heating and plumbing Competent Persons, Microgeneration and Energy Efficiency schemes.

The role is to manage the field-based team and assist them with managing member assessments and ensuring ongoing performance to meet our targets. You will need to have an understanding of the technologies we assess, in order to offer support for the team and on occasion attendance at seminars, roadshows and technical events/meetings will be required. Site shadow visits and assistance with complaint investigation is needed from time to time. Included within the role is key performance reporting and review and input to departmental policies and procedures.

Job Requirements:

You will need a proven track record in meeting objectives within agreed timescales and the ability to work flexibly, demonstrating initiative, whilst possessing key skills and competencies. You must have the ability to work to timeframes, demonstrate good reporting skills and be able to communicate effectively at all levels.
